CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY BURRIS
BAKER OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 35 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1904.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4046, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 27 2006, approving Transfer Application 8087.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use to the lands or place of use herein described.
