confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 80.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1867. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 1.0 cubic foot per second for Tract 2 and 1.0 cubic foot per second for Tract 3 or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
