Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of LONG TOM RIVER (WILLAMETTE RIVER), for IRRIGATION OF 63.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1865. The date of priority is MAY 22, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1150 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 36

The quantity of water diverted at the new well, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 29.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 34.0 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 3, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5264, and together with an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 3, 1983, cancelling a portion of this right, supersedes Certificate 32406, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
