This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of STANFIELD DRAIN, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 26.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 34.9 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18122. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 18, 1947. The right is limited to not more than 0.94 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1550 FEET NORTH AND 15 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 31), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

POD 1: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1550 FEET NORTH AND 15 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 31.

POD 2: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 850 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
