 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUBLE M RANCH, INC.
 31466 ANDREWS ROAD
 ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #1 and WELL #2, within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 49.80 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10222. The date of priority is JANUARY 10, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the WELLS.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to correct scrivener's errors contained in the certificate recorded at page 79540, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The scrivener's errors in Certificate 79540 appear in the ¼-¼ listing describing the place of use for the water right. This certificate supersedes Water Right Certificate 79540.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 8865, entered June 26, 2002, and recorded at Special Order Volume 56, Page 566.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
