CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. D. Brown
680 Elliott Avenue
Portland, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 28.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Enlargement Permit 87 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 389, on the 13th day of April, 1921. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1911.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE NW 4.6 ACRES
SECTION 12

NW NW 1.5 ACRES
SECTION 13

NE NE 12.0 ACRES
SE NE 10.0 ACRES
SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 22 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 3274, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 9, 2007, approving Transfer Application 10108.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
