Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the YAMHILL RIVER BASIN for the purpose of MUNICIPAL USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-1283. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1959. The right is limited to not more than 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 67, SECTION 25, T 5 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 172 FEET SOUTH AND 52.5 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 25.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the pump system shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new well shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 26, 1985 and supersedes certificate 28994, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
