A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN W. ROGERS

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 19.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27431. The date of priority is JUNE 5, 1961. This right is limited to 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1120 FEET SOUTH AND 610 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 13) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1750 FEET NORTH AND 2080 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 18.8 ACRES
SECTION 13

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season each year, provided further the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of Cow Creek is more than 11.0 cubic feet per second at its mouth.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 20, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5547, and supersedes Certificate 31351, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
