This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of the ALDER CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 0.2 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 18812. The date of priority is MAY 2, 1949. This right is limited to 0.002 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 450 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
