

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROMONA MORRIS
ROUTE 1, BOX 479
JOHN DAY, OREGON 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 9.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 24189. The date of priority is APRIL 30, 1956. The right is limited to not more than 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (if available at the original point of diversion, LAYCOCK-LONG DITCH: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 100 FEET NORTH AND 690 FEET EAST FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 21), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LAYCOCK-LONG DITCH: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.;
100 FEET NORTH AND 690 FEET EAST FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 21.

PUMP: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH
AND 880 FEET EAST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ 6.0 ACRES

SW¼ SE¼ 3.0 ACRES

SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion under the subject rights.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.


This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 26, 1981 approving Transfer Application 4846 and supersedes certificate 29844, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
