 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SPRINGS KNOWN AS SCOTT SPRINGS, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE OF 6 FAMILIES (5 Houses and 1 Trailer House).

This right was perfected under Permit 27466. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1961.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 30269, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 18, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 69, Page 611, approving a partial cancellation of a water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 30269.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
