This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARY HILDA TIRICO 401 SOUTH CANYON BOULEVARD JOHN DAY, OREGON 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE IRRIGATED FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30; FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND 3/4 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL FIVE ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR THE SEASON (if available at the original point of diversion, GEISLER DITCH - SW% NE%, SECTION 19, T 13 S, R 29 E, W.M.), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% SE%, SECTION 13, T 13 S, R 28 E, W.M.; 1110 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 13.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 3 (NW% SW%) 20.0 ACRES SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water at the original point of diversion under the subject right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 23, 1981, as amended by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 28, 1984, approving Transfer Application 4809, and supersedes Certificate 24897, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
