CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 3.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15 at page 461. The date of priority is 1905.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per acre irrigated per calendar month; total of 5.0 acre-feet per acre for season year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

POD 1: SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 8 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 900 FEET NORTH AND 2050 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 33.

POD 2: LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 5, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, LOT 4, SECTION 5.

POD 3: LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 5, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 750 FEET SOUTH AND 220 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, LOT 4, SECTION 5.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 3.5 ACRES  
SECTION 5  
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 25 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 18, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5258, and together with Certificate 52098, supersedes Certificate 25632, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
