 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HAL B. and GRACE J. DWIGHT
 RT 2 BOX 910
 ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 11.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-17860. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.145 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows: Lots 2 and 3, Block 11-Roseburg Home Orchard Tracts, being within Section 19, T26S, R6W, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 21350, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 6th, 2006, approving Transfer Application 9504.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
