Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of McCALL SPRING, a tributary of BAKER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD.

The right has been perfected under Permit 9207. The date of priority is AUGUST 20, 1929. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 1, T 4 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 30 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER DLC 55.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 5 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)  
SECTION 2  
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 28, 1980, approving Transfer Application 4613, and supersedes certificate 8470, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
