confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, tributary to the POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 198.0 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 252. The date of priority is 1903. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.68 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, from March 1st to October 1st of each year, the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 495.0 acre feet or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.
