Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BIRCH CREEK BASIN for the purpose of CLUBHOUSE USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-236. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1956. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE OLD WELL, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 1 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 2380 FEET NORTH AND 2570 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 15), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 15, T 1 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 180 FEET SOUTH AND 170 FEET EAST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 15.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 15  
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

The pump system shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled.

The quantity of water appropriated at the new well, together with that appropriated at the old well, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.


