A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL a tributary of SANFORD CANYON DRAINAGE COLUMBIA for IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-515. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1952. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 1 N, R 26 E, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 470 FEET EAST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water appropriated at the new well shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.3 ACRES
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.


The pump system shall include an access port for measuring water level and an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 8, 1987, approving Transfer Application 5904, and together with Certificate 56513, supersedes Certificate 29143, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
