The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

THE APPROPRIATION SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT OF WATER WHICH CAN BE APPLIED TO BENEFICIAL USE AND SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE-TENTH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH ONE THOUSAND HEAD OF STOCK, PROVIDED THAT AT TIMES WHEN NO WATER IS BEING DIVERTED FROM SILVER CREEK FOR IRRIGATION, SUCH QUANTITY OF WATER NOT TO EXCEED 1.0 CFS MAY BE DIVERTED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE WATERMASTER AS IS NECESSARY FOR PROPER DISTRIBUTION THROUGHOUT THE SYSTEM, PROVIDED THAT THE DITCHES ARE REGULARLY MAINTAINED IN GOOD CONDITION AND THAT ALL WATER USERS SHALL SO FAR AS PRACTICABLE PROVIDE STOCK WATERING HOLES OR PONDS INTO WHICH STOCK WATER MAY BE DIVERTED PERIODICALLY.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
