CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MICHAEL J. WIDMAN
ROUTE 2 BOX 90
BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 20.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 3782. The date of priority is May 2, 1918. The right is limited to 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 73410, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 27 2006 approving Transfer Application T-8697.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
