confirms the right to use the waters of East Fork of Williams Creek for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1889.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use) is as follows:

SE ¼ SW ¼ 2.0 ACRES SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 16331, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered <u>SEP 2 7 2006</u>, approving Transfer Application T-10147, and supersedes Certificate 82378.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
