CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D. C. WILSON
WILLIAMS, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of East Fork of Williams Creek, a tributary of Williams Creek, for IRRIGATION of 5.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is December, 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled for the purposes of the aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NE ¼ NW ¼, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE ¼ SW ¼ 5.8 ACRES
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 32960, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 27 2006, approving Transfer Application T-10147, and supersedes Certificate 82379.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
