A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK AND MARLENE STANLEY

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 73.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32864. The date of priority is OCTOBER 10, 1967. This right is limited to 1.84 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 8 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 450 FEET NORTH AND 2860 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 5.

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 1820 FEET SOUTH AND 4990 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 5.

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 6250 FEET SOUTH AND 5190 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 5.

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4	1.9 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.2 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	4.0 ACRES

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.


The quantity of water diverted at new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 25, 1987, approving Transfer Application 5961, and together with Certificate 57600 supersedes Certificate 36654, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
