This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DANIEL LEFORE 54257 HIGHWAY 332 MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of THE LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.21 ACRES. The certificate incorrectly described the source as the Little Walla Walla River and with this certificate is issued to correctly describe the source as the Ford Branch of the Little Walla Walla River, instead of the Little Walla Walla River.

This right was perfected under Permit 1102. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 23, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 6 N, R 35 E, W.M.; 1380 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.21 ACRES SECTION 26 TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 8, 1986, approving Transfer Application 5764, and supersedes Certificate 852 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
