This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of FORD BRANCH OF THE LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.79 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1905.
