 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BIDWELL CRAM
 GATEWAY, OREGON 97741

confirms the right to use the waters of HAY CREEK and WILSON CREEK, tributaries to the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 95.3 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 57. The dates of priority are 1885 for Hay Creek and 1886 for Wilson Creek.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 acre foot during any period of 30 days or 3.0 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season from Hay Creek and tributaries and the water diverted from Hay Creek shall not exceed 254.0 acre feet and from Wilson Creek 157.0 acre feet during any irrigation season.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
