A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK EVANS CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 14165. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1940. This right is limited to 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 34 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 160 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 ACRES  
SECTION 26  
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 3, 1983, and together with Certificate 51857, superseded Certificate 20713, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
