 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STANFIELD SCHOOL NO. DISTRICT 61
 PO BOX 158
 STANFIELD OR 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of STANFIELD DRAIN, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 36058. The date of priority is JUNE 16, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4 N	29 E	WM	32	NW SW	500 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF THE NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


