CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK E. MAGILL  
WAMIC, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE MILE CREEK, a tributary of WHITE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 8039. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1927. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 7372, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 3, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 70, Page 451, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 7372.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
