

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of 5 WELLS in the WILLAMETTE BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 266.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10063. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 3.33 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.95 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.65 CFS FROM WELL 4, 1.11 CFS FROM WELL 5, 0.48 CFS FROM WELL A, AND 0.14 CFS FROM WELL B or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 5: LOT 7 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 31, T 13 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1190 FEET NORTH AND 340 FEET EAST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

WELL 1: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 400 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

WELL 4: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 600 FEET SOUTH AND 650 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

WELL A: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 950 FEET SOUTH AND 2150 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

WELL B: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2300 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

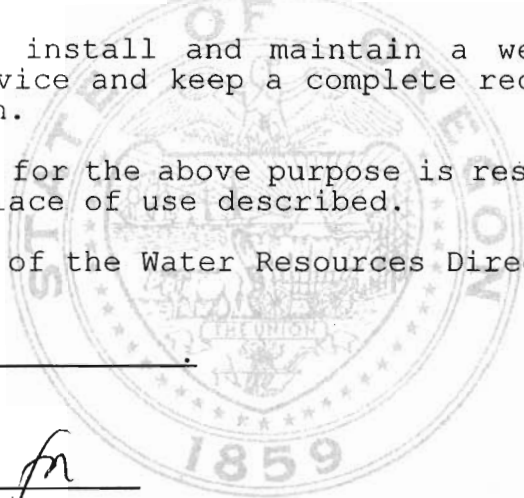
The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
