CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ESTATE OF MARGARET A. CUMMINS

of Jordan Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Bogus Creek for Tracts #1 & #2; West Fork of Fish Creek for Tract #3,
and East Fork Fish Creek for Tract #4for the purpose of Irrigation of Tracts #1 & #2; Irrigation, Domestic and Stock,
Tracts #3 and #4and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from March, 1898 for Tracts #1 & #2; November, 1907
for Tract #3; and November 29, 1905, for Tract #4that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 acre feet per acre
prior to June 1st, and $\frac{1}{2}$ acre foot per acre during any calendar month after June
1st, of each irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th, for irrigation pur-
poses. Amount hereinafter described for domestic and stock use.A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT #1: 8.8 acres in Lot 13, 21 acres in Lot 20, 0.5 acre in Lot 19, 0.6 acre
in Lot 21, Section 2, T. 29 S., R. 41 E., W.M., being a total of
30.9 acres.

TRACT #2: 4 acres in Lot 20, 9.6 acres in Lot 21 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 2, 0.8 acre in
Lot 17, Section 3, T. 29 S., R. 41 E., W.M., being a total of 14.4 acres.

TRACT #3: 13.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 2.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 27 S., R. 45 E.,
W.M., being a total of 15.7 acres.

TRACT #4: 1.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, 13.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, 1.4
acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, 3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 15 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec-
tion 29, T. 27 S., R. 45 E., W.M., being a total of 34.4 acres.

The right to divert and use water for stock and domestic purposes shall continue
throughout the year, provided the amount so diverted and used shall not exceed the rate
of one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock
outside of the irrigation season, and during the irrigation season shall not be en-
titled to divert any water for stock and domestic purposes in addition to the amount
which they are entitled to divert for irrigation purposes.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
