CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2 ACRES in Tract No. 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1875 for Tract No. 2.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND for Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use) is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of water for the purposes of aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
