 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELERY STONE
 PROVOLT, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson, Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523 . The date of priority is OCTOBER, 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which the water is appurtenant, is as follows:

lying South of the Applegate River in the following described tract:


Beginning at a point on the section line between Sections 1 and 12, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M., 590 feet West of the SE corner of said Section 1; thence running North 387.5 feet to the center of the county road; thence along the center line of said road North 57° West 759 feet; thence South 33° 45' West 165 feet; thence South 666.5 feet to the section line; thence East 730 feet to the point of beginning, containing 10 acres, more or less, in Section 1. Also beginning at the SE corner of Section 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M., and running thence West along the South line of said section a distance of 120 feet to the center line of said county road; thence Northwesterly along the center line of said county road to a point of intersection with the North line of the S½ SE¼ of said Section 1; thence East a distance of 1,940 feet, more or less, to the East line of said section; thence South 1,320 feet to the place of beginning, containing 30.3 acres, more or less, being within Josephine County.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of water for the purposes of aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 32813, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 18 2006 approving Transfer Application T-9726.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
