CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLEGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for DOMESTIC and IRRIGATION of 3.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is OCTOBER, 1898. The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.072 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which the water is appurtenant, is as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the NE½ NE½, Section 12, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M., thence South along the West line of said NE½ NE½ a distance of 70 rods; thence East 80 rods to the East line of said Section 12; thence North to the NE corner of said Section 12; thence West along the North line of said Section 12 to the point of beginning, less and excepting the following-described tract:

Beginning at the NE corner of said Section 12 and running thence South 355 feet on the section line; thence West 55 feet to the point of beginning; thence West 75 feet; thence South 50 feet; thence East 75 feet; thence North 50 feet, to the point of beginning.

Also less and excepting a tract of land described as follows: Beginning 214 feet South of the NE corner of said Section 12 on county line; thence West 150 feet; thence South 70 feet; thence East 150 feet to county line; thence North on county line 70 feet to beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
