CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is DECEMBER, 1908. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.212 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, measured at the point of diversion, from April 1 through October 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 32945, located in:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
38 S	5 W	WM	13	NW NW

To the mouth of Williams Creek, at River Mile 0.0.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 32945, and any related decree.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 70 Page 738, approving Transfer T-9726, and supercedes Certificate 32945, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
