## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to APPLEGATE RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27151. The date of priority is JANUARY 19, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.343 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from April 1 through June 29.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 49853, located approximately at:

To the mouth of Williams Creek, at River Mile 0.0.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cfs at its mouth. The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 49853, and any related decree.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 70 Page 73% approving Transfer T-9726, and supercedes Certificate 49853, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
