CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ESTATE OF ELERY STONE 14181 WILLIAMS HWY GRANTS PASS OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER and STONE RESERVOIR constructed under Application No. R-47599, Permit No. R-5734, tributary to APPLEGATE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 26.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35629. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.327 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
