

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SALLY SPRINGS 1 AND 2, tributaries of LOST RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY and IRRIGATION OF 21.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47168. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 6, 1981. This right is limited to 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.005 CFS for domestic use and 0.155 CFS for irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SALLY SPRING 1: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, T 38 S, R 14 E, WM; 2750 FEET SOUTH AND 10 WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 20.

SALLY SPRING 2: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, T 38 S, R 14 E, WM; 2730 FEET SOUTH AND 10 WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the water user has not waived or abandoned any vested water rights to the use of water from the sources described in the permit.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 10.0 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 11.4 ACRES DOMESTIC
 SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
