CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CARL W. FEGELY

of Vale, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Owyhee River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from November, 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre
during any calendar month prior to June 1st and $\frac{3}{4}$ acre foot per acre during any
calendar month after June 1st, of each year; and a total not to exceed 3 acre
feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

17.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot 1), 15.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot 2), 16 acres in
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 5.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 26 S., R.
43 E., W.M.

6.1 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot 1), 11 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot 1), Section 7,
T. 26 S., R. 44 E., W.M., being a total of 73.6 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
