

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM E. AND MILDRED TUCKER
2454 QUINES CREEK ROAD
AZALEA, OREGON 97410

confirms the right to use the waters of QUINES CREEK, a tributary of COW CREEK, for IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 1. The date of priority is JULY 25, 1894.

The use is limited to 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 950 FEET NORTH AND 690 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of the construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 15, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5395, and together with Certificate 51851, supersedes Certificate 9611, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
