CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARTHUR E PERKINS
HAINES OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE CREEK, tributary to the POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 80.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The dates of priority are: 1872 for 22.5 acres; 1880 for 7.5 acres; 1891 for 16.25 acres; 1897 for 18.75 acres; and 1904 for 15.0 acres.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WILLIAMS DITCH

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4403, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 28 1996, and recorded in Volume 50 Page 735, approving a petition by Kerns Brothers, Inc. under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This Certificate along with certificate 72612 supersedes Certificate 4403.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
