CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS, a tributary of MILL CREEK (PUDDING RIVER), for IRRIGATION OF 169.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4203. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.05 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, (IF LAWFULLY AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION BEING WELL #1 DESCRIBED AS BEING LOCATED WITHIN THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN RODDE DLC 57, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, WM; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 40 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, HOVENDEN DLC 76); or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

ORIGINAL WELL: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN RODDE DLC 57, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 40 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, HOVENDEN DLC 76

WELL #2: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN RODDE DLC 57, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 10 FEET SOUTH AND 1390 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, HOVENDEN DLC 76

WELL #3: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN HOVENDEN DLC 76, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1380 FEET NORTH AND 1520 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, HOVENDEN DLC 76

The amount of water used for IRRIGATION, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, together with the quantity diverted from the original point of appropriation (WELL #1), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm additional POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 10, 1994, approving Transfer Application 6531, and supersedes Certificate 42313, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
