A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO (2) WELLS in the ROCK CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 13.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8857. The date of priority is JUNE 6, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 70.7 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM), BEING 1.1 GPM FROM WELL 1, AND 69.6 GPM FROM WELL 2, or its equivalent case of rotation measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 4, T 3 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 640 FEET SOUTH AND 1060 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 4.

WELL 2: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 4, T 3 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 400 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acres, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right or the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 16, 2004, approving Transfer Application 7023, and together with Certificate 80784, supersedes Certificate 63591, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
