CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN CREEK, tributary to the JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 210.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Enlargement Permit E-62. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.625 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2057, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 14, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 70, Page 717, approving a partial cancellation of a water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 2057.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
