CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PINE HOLLOW COOPERATIVE, INC.
 ROUTE 1, BOX 27
 TYGH VALLEY, OR 97063

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE MILE CREEK and PINE HOLLOW RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-6368, tributaries of WHITE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 3378.87 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 39616. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3,491.45 ACRE FEET stored water only, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Water from the reservoir is to provide a supplemental supply for lands being benefited by exchange of water with lands below the reservoir under the terms of an agreement between the Badger Improvement District and Pine Hollow Cooperative, Inc., and the Pine Hollow Cooperative Water Users agreement. In the exchange, upper lands use water diverted for the lower lands entitled thereto and replace it in like amount from the reservoir. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
