CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THE CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF THE GRAND RONDE COMMUNITY OF OREGON

GRAND RONDE, OREGON 97347

confirms the right to use the waters of the YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL.

This right was perfected under Permit 9838. The date of priority is AUGUST 23, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR, AND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINTS OF DIVERSION LOCATED IN THE NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AND NW 1/4 NW 1/4, BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN KUYKENDALL DLC 57, Section 17, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN KUYKENDALL DLC 57, SECTION 17, T 6 S, R 7 W, W.M.; SOUTH 61° 42' 20" WEST 2703 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER OF KUYKENDALL DLC 57.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted from the original point(s) of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, CHARACTER OF USE, and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 20, 2003, and together with certificate 79950, supersedes Certificate 10973, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
