CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JERALD F. CLAUSEN

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 34.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1889.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 12 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 1010 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 35.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre per season, measured at points of diversion.

TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion (Murray Ditch) under the subject right.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;


the types and plans of measuring devices be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weirs or measuring devices be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 28, 1987, approving Transfer Application 5962, and supersedes Certificate 25612, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
