 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LORVAL JOHNSON
 ROUTE 153
 HALFWAY, OREGON 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP WELL and DRAIN TILES, a tributary of BEARWELLOW CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 26.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7752. The date of priority is JULY 20, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use of water under this right shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with other existing surface water rights.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52581, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 27 2007, and recorded in Special Order Volume 71, Page 16, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 52581.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
