CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID AXON

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in FORT ROCK VALLEY BASIN for IRRIGATION of 54.99 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10701. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.689 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81814 , State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 3, 2008 approving Transfer Application 10231.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
