 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE and SUPPLEMENATL IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7613. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.013 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right evidenced by Certificate 55013, State Record of Water Right Certificates, DIMINISHED from irrigation to supplemental irrigation by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 07 2007, and Recorded in Special Order Volume 71, Page 121, approving Transfer Application T-10252. This certificate also describes the irrigation component of the water right NOT modified by the order approving T-10252. This certificate supersedes Certificate 55013.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
